

How to Pay a Crypto Invoice - [3 Steps]

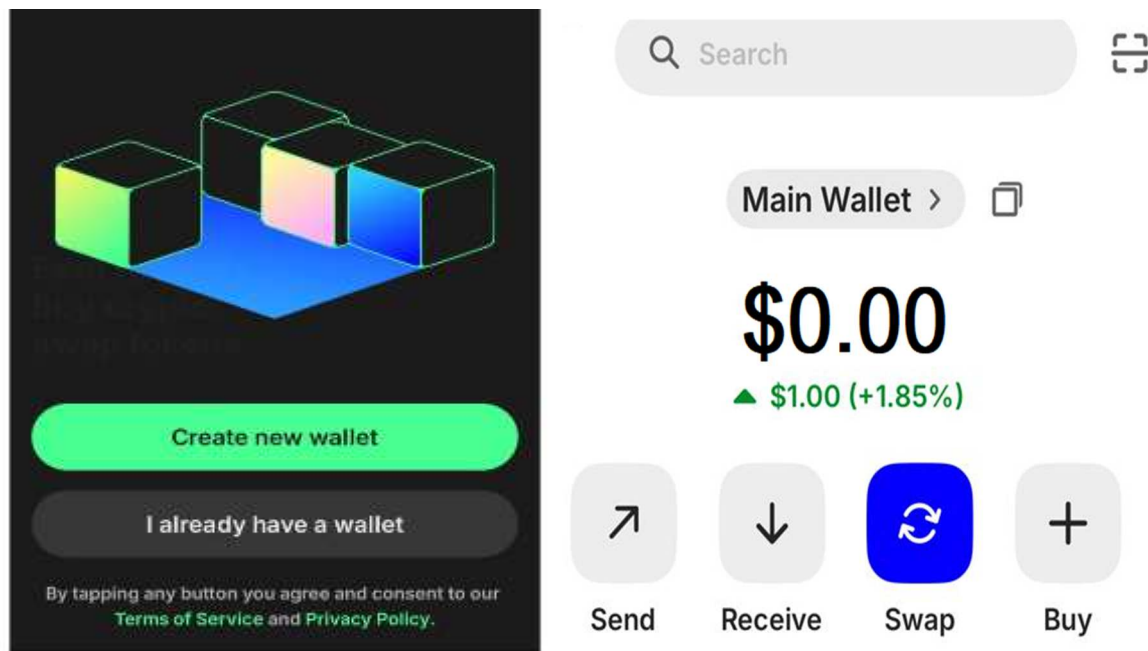
To make crypto invoice payment, make a screen shot of the invoice QR code and look for an E-currency vendor in your location to assist you complete the payment or follow the steps below to make the payment yourself.

Step 1: Get a Crypto Wallet:

There are various options available for a crypto wallet each with varying benefits. For this guide, we'll be using a third-party service called **Trust wallet**.

To set-up a Crypto wallet follow these steps below;

1. Install "**Trust Wallet**" application from your mobile Play Store or App Store.
2. Open the installed app and create a new wallet and password.



That's it! You just created a crypto wallet that you can now use to pay crypto invoices.

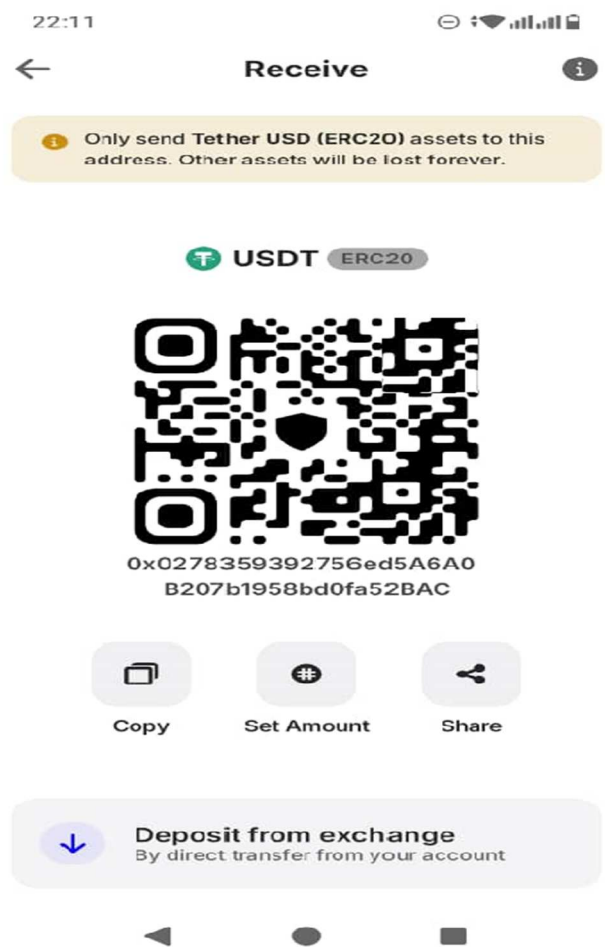
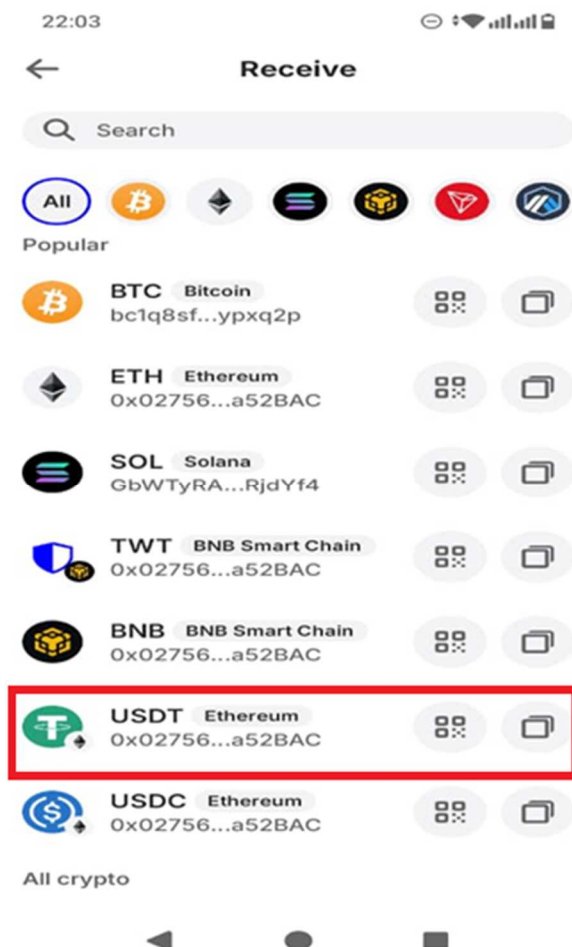
3. You can now use the "**Send/Receive**" buttons to send or receive crypto currencies.

When you click on the '**Receive**' button,



it will display all your crypto wallet addresses.

This address is called a crypto wallet address. It looks like a string of random letters and numbers e.g (T**HE**x**Pb**8g**XG**ayw**Jh**U**fV**W**f8KR8X**k**jGF9mr**), which is a unique address valid for your wallet. You can use this address to receive digital currencies like USDT into your USDT wallet as below. All crypto currencies have their different unique wallet addresses.



Step 2: Purchase Crypto currency to fund your wallet:

Once you have created your Crypto wallet, it's now time to fill it up with some cryptocurrencies (we'll be using a cryptocurrency called **USDT**). To purchase **USDT** or any type of cryptocurrency, the most convenient and secure way is to use a local crypto exchange in your country, or buy directly from the app with your credit card or any other method available to you. You can use Google to search for "**Buy crypto instantly**" in your country to find local vendors.

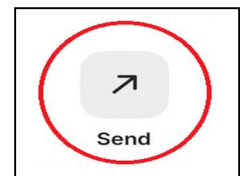
There are many cryptocurrency exchanges available that can be used to purchase crypto for fiat currency. Payment options vary but the majority of exchanges have the option to pay via local bank transfer while some accept other methods of payment. You can choose the one most convenient to you and sign up.

Once you have signed up with your preferred Local Cryptocurrency Exchange, you can purchase **USDT** or any E-currency of your choice depending on the payment you want to make. For example, you can buy USDT for USDT payment only, Bitcoin for bitcoin payment only etc. Once your Local Cryptocurrency Exchange receives your order and payment, you will receive your purchased coin in your crypto wallet in few minutes.

Step 3: Pay your Crypto Invoice:

Once you have succeeded in funding your wallet, you can now pay crypto invoices.

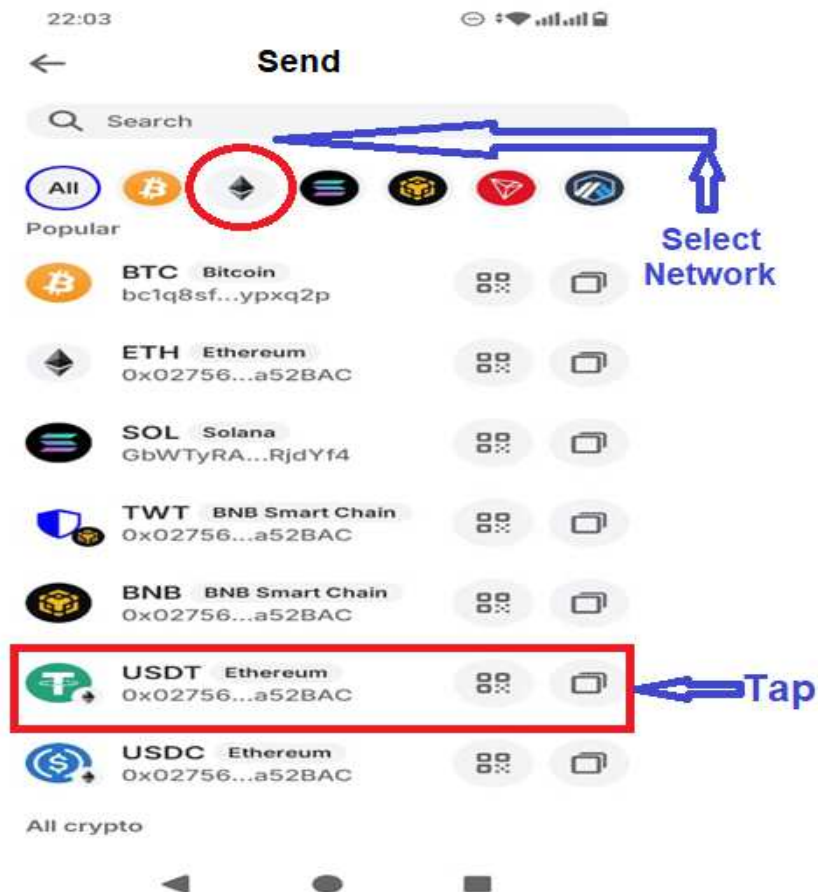
To pay the invoice you have to tap on the **"send"** button on your Trust wallet app and follow these steps below:-



1. Copy the Invoice Crypto (USDT) Address:

Copy the crypto address from the invoice you want to pay, then go to your Trust wallet app and tap on **"send"**. Then choose the currency and network you are paying with (e.g **USDT**), and then paste in the invoice crypto address to make the

payment. You can as well scan the **QR code** on the invoice using your phone, to automatically input the invoice crypto address.

2. Copy the Invoice USDT Amount:

Copy the USDT amount mentioned in the invoice and paste into your Trust wallet to make the payment. You can as well type in the amount into your app.

3. Send the USDT payment:

Now you have successfully entered all necessary details, you can now go ahead and click **“Next”** button to complete the payment.



VERY IMPORTANT!!!: Please be very mindful of the **“Currency”** and **“Network”** you select when making crypto purchase and invoice payment to avoid loss of funds. Ensure **“Currency”** and **“Network”** you purchase matches and corresponds with the **“Currency”** and **“Network”** of the invoice you are paying. All payments must be made in USDT only despite the network you chose. Take note of the three (3) invoice networks and it's currency below accordingly:

<u>NETWORK:</u>		<u>CURRENCY:</u>
ETHEREUM	-	Tether - USDT (ERC-20)
TRON	-	Tether - USDT (TRC-20)
BSC	-	Tether - USDT (BEP-20).

Ways to Fund Your Crypto (Trust) Wallet:

- **Credit/Debit Card:**

This method is the most convenient, but seems impossible due to bank regulations on high volatility digital assets.

- **Buy from Local Vendors:**

This method has the highest success rate in purchasing digital assets. Kindly type this keyword ***“Buy crypto instantly in (Your Country)”*** in Google to search for local crypto vendors in your country to purchase any crypto currency. Replace ***(Your Country)*** with *your actual country*.

- **Bitcoin ATMs:**

This provide medium-low anonymity, enabling cash-to-crypto purchases without extensive identification. Check the links below to see if you can find one in your location:
